### Parent Teacher Conferences

If more time is needed for any family, we will follow-up to schedule another time to continue our discussion. ## Before & After School

Students are allowed to enter the building starting at 8:00am daily. If students are getting help from a teacher before school, they may go directly to the teacher for help. If the teacher is not available or if help is not needed, the student **MUST** go directly to the multi. Students must be picked up after school by 3:40pm, unless they have made arrangements to get help from a teacher.

Students may not stay after school on the playground unless they are within direct parent supervision. Students in violation of these expectations will receive a Level II disciplinary referral.

## Updated Online Student Expectations



Starting on November 2nd, all online students will be considered virtually present **only** if the video camera is turned on and the student's entire face is visible throughout the class period. If the student's entire face is **NOT** visible, the student will be marked as an unexcused absence for that class period. If your student does not have video capability, please email the student's homeroom teacher to let us know..
